Here is a list of items that can <u>NOT</u> go to the **NYS VETERANS' HOME**, at OXFORD:

NOT ALLOWED/ DO *NOT* BRING:

Disposable razors, nail clippers, nail files or anything that can be considered a weapon such as sharp objects, knives, scissors, etc.

Shaving cream, perfumed based items, toiletries -

Personal care items like - lotions, nail polish, nail polish remover, and thing that could be taken orally or put on skin, as many are allergic to these things.

Anything considered "over the counter" medications

Lighters, candles, or anything flammable.

Glass or any breakable objects.

Electrical appliances (hot plates, heating pads, coffee makers, electric blankets, etc) Cleaning supplies

Foods made in your home. Any food must be made at the Oxford Home for residents to consume.

Suggested items:

• Large Print Activity Books: like puzzles, crosswords, word finds, etc

- Reading, especially LARGE print: books UP-TO-DATE magazines
- Personal sound system (iPods)
- Internet Radios
- New Movies: DVD's
- Music: CD'S (and music books)
- Sweat shirts/pants (all sizes) XL, XXL and 3XL preferred
- Cardigans with buttons (XL, XXL preferred)
- Baseball Caps
- Electric razors
- Arts & Crafts items (small wooden boxes, bird houses, etc.)
- Puzzles (less than 500 pieces)
- Blankets: only "Bed size afghans" (they have way too many lap sized ones now.)
